CIRCULAR

Keeping in view the Public Notice issued by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, U.T. Chandigarh, the residents of the P.U. Campuses, Sector 14 & 25, Chandigarh, who have kept Pet Dogs at their premises, are hereby advised to follow the instructions in this regard, as under:

- 1. The residents of the P.U. Campuses who have kept pet dogs must get them registered with M.C. Chandigarh in accordance with Pet Dog Bye Laws, 2010.
- 2. Keep the dog protected by getting it vaccinated against rabies from a Govt. or private veterinary practitioner, duly registered with Veterinary Council of India (VCI) or State Veterinary Council (SVC) and maintain the vaccination record duly attested by the vaccinating authorities.
- 3. Keep the dog chained/teased while taking it outside (except prohibited areas, specified in Pet Dog Bye-Laws 2010.
- 4. Ferocious dogs must be duly muzzled and a stick must be carried by the escort accompanying the dog.
- 5. Straying Pet Dogs will be impounded.
- 6. Must keep the dog under control all the time, so it does not intimidate, annoy, hurt or bite any person. If dog does, the owner will compensate the victim at his/her own level.
- 7. Metal token issued by the registration authority must be affixed with neck collar of the dog at all the times.
- 8. Breeding and trading of dogs for commercial purposes within the area of Municipal Corporation is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Littering/defecation at public places is not allowed. Owner will be liable to get it cleaned.
- 10. Proper space, accommodation, food & medical treatment of the dog must be ensured by the owner.
- 11. Dead animal must be buried by the owner at his own level in the area specified by the Municipal Corporation.
- 12. Violators will be penalized as per the Pet Dog Bye-Laws 2010 & amendment thereof.
