

CIRCULAR

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, in anticipation of approval of the Syndicate, has allowed to adopt the following guidelines/instructions issued by the Additional Chief Secretary, Deptt. of Health & Family Welfare, Government of Punjab vide No. COVID19-NHM/2020/4HB4/242 dated 7.8.2020 w.r.t. workers residing in containment and micro-containment zones:-

"To contain and manage COVID-19 pandemic, Government has been notifying containment and micro-containment zones which are put in perimeter control restricting movement of people. Workers residing in such zones cannot move out for about 14 days and go to work. Therefore, all such workers residing in containment and micro-containment zones should be treated on duty by all Government and private commercial organizations, during the period of such containment."
