OBSERVANCE OF SILENCE ON 30TH JANUARY, 2024 (TUESDAY) (MARTYRS' DAY) IN THE MEMORY OF THOSE WHO SACRIFICED THEIR LIVES IN THE STRUGGLE FOR INDIA'S FREEDOM.

As in the previous years, Silence will be observed in the Union Territory of Chandigarh for two minutes at 11.00 A.M. on the 30TH JANUARY, 2024 (TUESDAY) in the memory of those who sacrificed their lives in the struggle for India's Freedom. The commencement and termination of the two minutes silence will be indicated by the 'All Clear' sirens at 10.59 A.M. and 11.02 A.M. respectively. The sirens will blow for one minute in each case from 10.59 A.M. to 11.00 A.M. and 11.02 A.M. to 11.03 A.M. The two minutes silence will be observed from 11.00 A.M. to 11.02 A.M.

- On hearing the signal to be indicated by the first siren, all persons should, wherever, they are, stand up and observe the silence. It would be more effective and impressive if persons could gather at one place for observing the silence instead of each person standing where he is. If the number of employees are large in any industry or office, there may be more than one gathering. No efforts need, however, be made to collect people together, if it is likely to involve serious dislocation of work.
- During the period of silence, all workshops and factories should stop work where practicable and traffic on the roads should come to a stand still.
- For Director General of Police and Director Transport, Chandigarh Transport Undertaking, Chandigarh: They will please persuade the traffic in the Union Territory, Chandigarh to come to a standstill at that time.
- For General Manager, District Industries Centre and Assistant Labour Commissioner, Chandigarh: They will please persuade workers in all the factories, shops, business establishments and cinemas etc. to observe two minutes silence at the appointed date and time.
- Silence will be observed in front of Chandigarh Secretariat, Sector-9, Chandigarh on the 30th January, 2024 (Tueday) as per programme given below:-

10.45 A.M. Officer and staff assemble in front of the Chandigarh Secretariat.

10.50 A.M. Police Guard of Honour Forms up.

10.56 A.M. Guard Slopes arms.

Adviser to the Administrator arrives. 10.57 A.M

Guard Commander gives order to present arms rest on reserved arms. Buglars 10.58 A.M. sound the last post. All present should stand up when the Guard reversed arms.

On the last note of the last post, siren is sounded to signal the start of the 11.00 A.M period of two minutes during which silence is to be observed.

The Siren is sounded to signal the end of the two minutes. The Guard present 11.02 A.M arms/The Buglars sound the Revella, whereafter the Guard Slopes arms, order

Subject:- Observance of silence on 30th January (Martyrs' Day) in the memory of those who sacrificed their lives during struggle for India's freedom-

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that on 30th January, every year, two minutes' silence is observed at 11.00 AM., throughout the country, in the memory of those who sacrificed their lives during the struggle for India's freedom.

- The following standing instructions have been laid down for observance of this day:
 - Silence should be observed and work and movement stopped for two (i) minutes throughout the country at 11.00 A.M. on 30th January.
 - (ii) Wherever feasible, the commencement and termination of the two minutes' silence period should be indicated by sound of siren or Army guns. Sirens should be sounded from 10.59 hours till 11.00 hours and after two minutes, all clear sirens should again be sounded from 11.02 hours till 11.03 hours. This procedure may be adopted where sirens exist.
 - (iii) On hearing the signal (wherever available), all persons would stand up and observe the silence.
 - (iv) At places where no signal systems is available, suitable instructions can be issued to all concerned for observing the silence for two minutes at 11.00 A.M.
- In the past, it has been observed that while two minutes' silence is observed in some offices, the general public goes about its occupation in the ordinary course, unmindful of the solemnity of the occasion. The State/Union Territories Governments are requested to ensure that the Martyrs' Day is observed with due solemnity. State/Union Territories Government may issue instructions to all educational institutions and Public Sector Enterprises under their control for observance of the Martyrs' Day, accordingly. Talks/speeches on freedom struggle and national integration may also be organised including in hybrid mode.

मुझे यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि भारत के स्वतंत्रता संग्राम में अपने प्राणों की आहुति देने वाले शहीदों की याद में प्रति वर्ष 30 जनवरी को पूरे देश में पूर्वाह्न 11.00 बजे दो मिनट का मौन रखा जाता है।

- 2. इस दिवस को मनाने के संबंध में निम्नलिखित स्थाई अनुदेश निर्धारित किए गए हैं :
 - (i) 30 जनवरी को पूर्वाह्न 11.00 बजे पूरे देश में मौन रखा जाना चाहिए और काम तथा गतिविधियों को रोक दिया जाना चाहिए।
 - (ii) जहां कहीं संभव हो, दो मिनट के मौन की अवधि शुरू होने तथा समाप्त होने की सूचना सायरन बजाकर या आर्मी गन से दी जानी चाहिए। सायरन 10.59 बजे से 11.00 बजे तक बजाए जाने चाहिए और दो मिनट के बाद 11.02 बजे से 11.03 बजे तक पुन: क्लियर सायरन बजाए जाने चाहिए। जहां सायरन उपलब्ध हो वहां यह कार्यविधि अपनाई जाए।
 - (iii) सिगनल (जहां उपलब्ध हो), सुनकर सभी व्यक्ति खड़े हो जाएं और मौन धारण करें।
 - (iv) जिन स्थानों पर सिगनल की कोई व्यवस्था न हो, वहां पूर्वाह्न 11.00 बजे दो मिनट का मौन रखने के लिए सभी संबंधितों को उपयुक्त अनुदेश दिए जा सकते हैं।
- 3. विगत में यह देखा गया है कि यद्यपि कुछ कार्यालयों में दो मिनट का मौन रखा जाता है, परंतु आम जनता इस अवसर की गंभीरता पर ध्यान दिए बिना सामान्य रूप से अपने काम में लगी रहती है। राज्यों/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र सरकारों से अनुरोध है कि शहीद दिवस को पूरी गम्भीरता के साथ मनाया जाए। राज्य/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र सरकारें, तदनुसार, शहीद दिवस को मनाने के संबंध में अपने नियंत्रणाधीन सभी शैक्षिक संस्थाओं और सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र के उपक्रमों को अनुदेश जारी कर सकती हैं। स्वतंत्रता संग्राम और राष्ट्रीय एकता के बारे में वार्ताएं / भाषण हाइब्रिड मोड में भी आयोजित किए जाएं।
